Scripture Reading: Joshua 24:14-28

Joshua: Now therefore revere the Lord, and serve God in sincerity and in faithfulness. Put away the gods that your ancestors served beyond the River and in Egypt, and serve the Lord. Now if you are unwilling to serve the Lord, choose this day whom you will serve, whether the gods your ancestors served in the region beyond the River or the gods of the Amorites in whose land you are living. But as for me and my household, we will serve the Lord.

People: **Far be it from us that we should forsake the Lord to serve other gods; for it is the Lord our God who brought us and our ancestors up from the land of Egypt, out of the house of slavery, and who did those great signs in our sight. God protected us along all the way that we went, and among all the peoples through whom we passed; and the Lord drove out before us all the peoples, the Amorites who lived in the land. Therefore we will serve the Lord, who is our God.**

Joshua: You cannot serve the Lord, who is a holy and jealous God, and who will not forgive your transgressions or your sins. If you forsake the Lord and serve foreign gods, then God will turn and do you harm, and consume you, after having done you good.

People: **No, we will serve the Lord!**

Joshua: You are witnesses against yourselves that you have chosen to serve the Lord.

People: **We are witnesses.**

Joshua: Then put away the foreign gods that are among you, and incline your hearts to the Lord, the God of Israel.

People: **The Lord our God we will serve and obey.**

Narrator: *So Joshua made a covenant with the people that day, and made statutes and ordinances for them at Shechem. Joshua wrote these words in the book of the law of God; and he took a large stone, and set it up there under the oak in the sanctuary of the Lord.*

Joshua: See, this stone shall be a witness against us; for it has heard all the words that God spoke to us; therefore it shall be a witness against you, if you deal falsely with your God.
