Help! Wow! Thanks! Luke 17:11-19 Sermon by Mag Richer Smith November 25, 2018

<sup>11</sup>On the way to Jerusalem Jesus was going through the region between Samaria and Galilee. <sup>12</sup>As he entered a village, ten lepers approached him. Keeping their distance, <sup>13</sup>they called out, saying, "Jesus, Master, have mercy on us!" <sup>14</sup>When he saw them, he said to them, "Go and show yourselves to the priests." And as they went, they were made clean. <sup>15</sup>Then one of them, when he saw that he was healed, turned back, praising God with a loud voice. <sup>16</sup>He prostrated himself at Jesus' feet and thanked him. And he was a Samaritan. <sup>17</sup>Then Jesus asked, "Were not ten made clean? But the other nine, where are they? <sup>18</sup>Was none of them found to return and give praise to God except this foreigner?" <sup>19</sup>Then he said to him, "Get up and go on your way; your faith has made you well."

IN Guatemala City, one of the biggest garbage pits in the world can be viewed from a cemetery overlook. And from that vantage point, one can see people moving about in the trash, making their homes in the squalor and stench,

scavenging to eek out their subsistence while vultures are hovering overhead.

THIS is <u>not</u> <u>un</u>like **the setting** of our text: Lepers are dwelling in the **garbage pit** of their day... It lies **outside** the WALL, on the **margins** where the <u>UNACCEPTABLE</u>, UNWANTED folks dwell.

And what we hear as the lepers emerge from the shadows are the *clanging* of BELLS around their necks... and shouts of "UNCLEAN! warning others to stay clear, while arms (minus thumbs & fingers) beg for scraps to be thrown in their direction. LEPROSY was the **most dreaded** form of **social austracism** in biblical times, and the book of LEVITICUS gives **LEPERS these** instructions:

"Let those who have the disease wear torn clothes and let their hair hang loose, and cover their lips and cry: "Unclean! Unclean!" "And the leper shall remain <u>un</u>clean as long as he has the disease and shall dwell alone in a habitation OUTSIDE THE CAMP!" Lonliness, Isolation, Humiliation ... And anyone can catch it!!

Anyone...no matter how good or healthy we've have been.. **WE** can get it too!

- It's that **diagnosis** we have *dreaded*
- The **break up** we did *not want*
- The family scars we did not deserve
- The **troubles** we did *not expect.*

Though **LIFE OUTSIDE THE CAMP** may <u>NOT</u> seem like the **normal** place of **residence** for *privileged* people, We **all know** something about the garbage heap of life. BECAUSE as Anne La Motte reminds us: "WE'RE ALL SCREWED UP, BROKEN, CLINGY, AND SCARED, EVEN THE PEOPLE WHO SEEM TO HAVE IT MORE OR LESS TOGETHER."

LEPROSY IS **CONTAGIOUS** AND **NONE OF US** IS IMMUNE FROM SHAME or PAIN.

But on this particular day, there is a

# FLICKER IN THE DARK, a WHISPER of HOPE

And his name is JESUS.

AND HE'S is "**on his way** to Jerusalem" to SUFFER outside **THE WALL OUTSIDE** THE CITY GATE.

And TODAY HE's in that MARGINAL BORDERLAND WHERE NOBODY'S AT HOME,

*choosing* to walk where humanity's aching bells are clanging...

Here he is and we can see him...

- sitting with those longing for asylum
- hanging out with all the world's fears and restlessness...
- protesting all that's UNJUST,
- And Embracing those whom society has deemed unwell & unwelcome.

We see <u>this</u> Jesus **anytime someone** *risks* leaving their own **comfort inside** the camp to venture into another's experience of **exclusion, abandonment, suffering &loss.** 

Jesus **goes to the edge** on behalf of humankind... And the lepers recognize him!

> "Jesus, Master!" they cry, "Jesus, Master, have mercy on us!"

It is *the* ULTIMATE cry for HELP ! the *Kyrie...* OUR HEART'S *longing for liberation,* and the WORLD'S *yearning for healing*. *Jesus, Master, have mercy on us!* 

## **KYRIE ELEISON!**

#### IT is the PRAYER God <u>ALWAYS</u> *hears!* Because God is <u>all-merciful.</u>

So let us join the LEPERS in their heatrcry today (#144 in the blue book). We will sing this once, hum it 2 times and then sing the words once more.

Lord, have MERCY! On your fractured earth... On the people of Yemen, On the refugees fleeing violence, and on all who dwell in the garbage pits of life longing for a Way to hope~ LORD, HAVE MERCY!

On ALL of US who are ACHING, Grieving, weary, afraid, And on all that holds us captive & keeps us from walking free. *Jesus, Master, Heal us with your MERCY.* 

\* \* \* \* \* \* \* \* \*

Now Jesus doesn't **run** toward the lepers with his mercy... (There is no **spittle** or **mud** or a **recognition of FAITH)** There is simply an invitation to **walk in trust**:

"Go show yourselves to the priest."

*Jesus* sends them out from the margin outside the wall~ to the center of the City,

calling these **outcasts** to a radical **belief in their own dignity**!

There is only 1 reason for a leper to go to the priest and that is to **receive a diagnosis**:

Clean scans/ or messy tumors? Valid members of community or unwelcome? "clean or unclean." So all 10 take to the road and "As they go" they experience healing AS THEY GO...

Healing does not usually occur overnight... IT is a JOURNEY. BUT... little by little as more is entrusted to the <u>Divine Lover's saving grace</u>, more and more healing is experienced.

Cleansing for the LEPERS happens **as their** "**souls feel their worth**"...as they move from the garbage heap on THE MARGINS, and ever-so- gradually, **LET their "BELOVEDNESS**" soak into their **self-doubt**.

Here they are EXPERIENCING **THE "WOW"** of the GRACE that says,

"THERE YOU ARE AND I LOVE YOU THERE as MUCH AS I WILL LOVE YOU ANYWHERE." (Right where you're sitting today).

**THIS** IS THE MIRACLE OF HEALING. All 10 move **forward trusting** that LOVE~ right here, right now. AND **1 turns back**... this one (whose bell has long rung out all that he is NOT~ all **his LACK**) is *now singing* a song that *overrides* that **old death knell** & like the poet of Psalm 30, he declares:

Lord, you have turned my mourning into dancing... Taken off my sackcloth So that my soul may praise you & not be silent... O my Lord, I will give you THANKS forever! The 10<sup>th</sup> leper's return is <u>no quiet</u> Thanksgivng Day, but a passionate LOUD spectacle of Praise and Gratitude.

### And he is a SAMARITAN!

...the enemy (who will continue to be **harassed**, **bullied** and **unwelcome** inside the camp in Jerusalem,

(no matter if he is healed of his dis-ease or not).
But he has <u>stopped</u> giving POWER to others to define him & make him WORTHY. (It's not about what others think.) His identity is now in BEING the "BELOVED", & he CLAIMS IT and comes back, bowing before Jesus, laying <u>his face in the dirt</u> in unabashed GRATITUDE!

Jesus welcomes this lavish response,

but GRIEVES **the** <u>lack</u> of gratitude among his **own people**: "Were not ten made clean? But the other 9...where are THEY? Was none found to RETURN & GIVE PRAISE to GOD, except this FOREIGNER?"

Jesus **longs for his own people** to *RECOGNIZE* the gift.

"Where are the other 9?"

They are *cured* of leprosy, and will likely be **reinstated** into community... But thus far, they have <u>not</u> experienced the <u>deeper healing</u> the 10<sup>th</sup> leper knows: The healing that has taken in the LOVE of GOD and makes us ever-grateful!

# We were made to **PRAISE**.

Scientists have learned that the **brain stores music** in **both** its lobes, so music fills our <u>whole being</u> and pours forth from us, even when **language and cognition** are gone. Music is the **vessel of PRAISE.** 

People who work with **children** in the area of their spiritual development have discovered that the **prayers of children** up to ages 7 or 8 are almost **exclusively** prayers of **THANKSGIVING**. But praise and gratitude grow more *dim* with our adult *cynicism*.

### An ancient **proverb** says: "IT IS IMPOSSIBLE to hold both Resentment & Gratitude at the same time."

Maybe that's why **my Most gracious friend's mantra** is: "*THANKS BE TO GOD!"* 

-And maybe that's why when I **am leveling a complaint** at my spouse, he frequently stops me and says:

*"Tell me 3 things you love about me!"* When I can get there after being **stuck** in a place of FRUSTRATION & **ANGER**, **Gratitude FREES me**!

THE 10<sup>th</sup> leper experiences LIBERATION

and the word in Greek is "*SOZO"...* which means: *SALVATION/ WHOLENESS/ SHALOM.* 

"Get up," Jesus says, "Go your way." Your faith has saved you, made you well & offered you shalom.

Joan Chiddister says that

"to be saved is to see Jesus there on the <u>edge</u>, ready to receive OUR tattered souls... To know that in our descent into the darkness, God will be there holding & offering us hope."

#### **Desmond TUTU says:**

"to be saved and made whole is to grasp God's dream for a WORLD whose ugliness, squalor, poverty, wars, hostility, greed, competition and alienation is TRANSFORMED!

*It is to know the world as* **1** *human family and* **to know ourselves** *as* **the beloved**.

Wm. Sloan Coffin says:

To be made whole is to believe in Jesus because we have seen him change:

Addictions into freedom/ Hate-filled relationships into loving ones/& the fatigue of despair into the buoyancy of hope. What is important is <u>not</u> that

> CHRIST is GOD-LIKE... But that God is CHRIST–LIKE."

And all of these people of faith tell us that SALVATION frees us to GRATITUDE, & Gratitude frees us to FORGIVENESS, & Forgiveness frees us to SHALOM & WHOLENESS!

**Yvonne Dilling**, who served in Hondurus with the Salvadorian Refugees, wrote about the structure in those camps: "As soon as the refugees begin to make a new camp, they set up **three committees**:

A committee for **education**, a committee for **construction**, and a committee for **JOY!** 

CELEBRATION and Praise is as <u>basic</u> to the life of the refugees as teaching their children to read & building a latrine."

Dilling says, " I am convinced that those people on whose behalf we often feel so much **discouragement and guilt**, would be **absolutely thrilled** if **WE WOULD LET LOOSE** once in a while, **ABONDONING OURSELVES** to some good old **PRAISE and THANKSGIVING!**"

If we want our lives to be converted to **be at one with those who suffer**, and **advocate** for **healing for the lepers** in our world, then we need a deep **conversion to GRATITUDE, PRAISE, JOY**...

To giving thanks for WHO GOD is... The God who is Christ-like.. The God who in Jesus goes to the border, outside the wall... Descends into the garbage beap of our live

*Descends* into the **garbage heap of our lives**, Listens to our heartcries and offers:

MERCY upon mercy upon mercy, Reminding us at every turn that we, Like JESUS, are GOD's own BELOVED, and that is enough.

So we are invited today to join that LEPER whose soul has felt its WORTH in his LOUD, passionate THANKSGIVING and PRAISE...Let us sing our praise to the GOD from whom <u>all</u> blessings flow!
